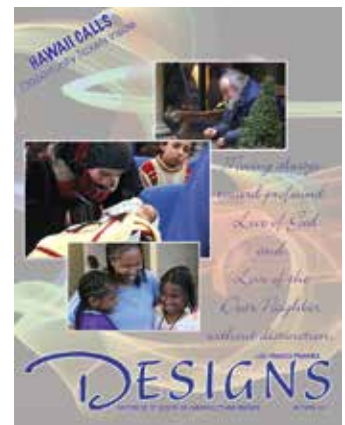
CC Staff Picnic

Parliament of the World's Religions



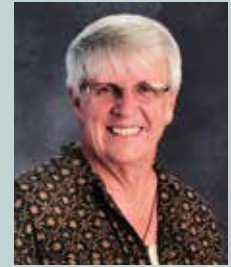
"Inclusion" and "Love" as Major Themes of 2018 International Convening in Toronto
