Socks and Tarps for the Homeless in Los Angeles



*Note: A few months ago, the Los Angeles Catholic Worker, a non-profit organization dedicated to feeding the hungry, sheltering the homeless, caring for the sick, clothing the naked and visiting the prisoner, received a Dear Neighbor Fund Grant. The needs of the thousands of homeless living on skid row are endless. We try to fill some of those needs when we can. The Los Angeles Catholic Worker provides foot care every Friday. You can imagine how needed this care is, as the folks are walking all the time to comply with the city ordinance to not stand, sit or lie down on the sidewalk. As part of the foot care, people are given a new pair of socks. During the clinic time, anyone can come by for new socks, and many do. Many of our guests are diabetic and should have special socks, which we try to supply.

There are many situations that are helped by having a tarp. Just lying down for the night, putting a tarp down where one is going to camp for the night, provides a clean space. Many people carry their belongings in a shopping cart and a tarp makes a perfect cover. In the absence of a tent, you can create a shelter. On hot days, you can create a shade space. Trees are in short supply on the row and creating shade is an important safeguard. When the hot days turn into chilly nights, a tarp pulled over a thin blanket gives extra warmth. And, if all that is available is a tarp, it can be an emergency blanket. The grant from the Sisters of St. Joseph has helped us to continue providing these items to our clients. ❖
