Walk with Wisdom is a six-part series offered by the St. Louis province that invites Sisters, Associates and partners in mission to engage in prayer, facilitated conversations and shared experiences that deepen their understanding of the CSJ charism and discover a gospel-centered way to proceed in one's discussion of justice issues. Each session of this curriculum-based program focuses on building right relationships through topics such as charism, worldview, stereotypes and conflict.
