Parish Grief Response Team

Help Victims of Crime in Los Angeles

Note: Last year, the Office of Restorative Justice of the Los Angeles Archdiocese (ORJ), received a grant from our Dear Neighbor Fund to help, train, and form first responder teams serving victims of crime within Our Lady of the Angels Region. The project initiated within the Our Lady of the Angels Region because it was identified as high need due to elevated crime and low socio-economic status. Funding for the Dear Neighbor Grants comes in part from our Annual Hawaii Calls Opportunity Drawing and the Angel Boutique.

Parishioners within Our Lady of the Angels Region are gravely victimized by crime. Multiple factors present themselves as obstacles to obtaining assistance and healing. Funding from the Dear Neighbor Grant has allowed for the ORJ to provide trained Parish Grief Response team designees with the tools to help parishioners during trauma and grief. Services include compassionate and effective service that meet their unique need(s) as victims of crime, such as counseling and medical referrals. ❖
