<p><b>DAY: 93</b> TUESDAY <b>APR 21</b></p>	<p>Lord of hope, today I pray for the grace to appreciate the gifts this challenging time presents us all: new ways to enjoy community, fewer distractions from what is most important, good health, loved ones, and available resources.</p>
<p><b>DAY: 94</b> WEDNESDAY <b>APR 22</b></p>	<p><b>EARTH DAY</b> ~ Today I pray a prayer of thanksgiving for the world we live in, for the beauty of land and sea, plants and animals, and my brothers and sisters. I pray for the wisdom to care for God's creation.</p>
<p><b>DAY: 95</b> THURSDAY <b>APR 23</b></p>	<p>Generous Lord, today I pray for patience as this time of sheltering in place grows long. I pray for wisdom and understanding when confronted with the frustrations of those with whom I shelter.</p>
<p><b>DAY: 96</b> FRIDAY <b>APR 24</b></p>	<p>Today I give thanks for technology that bridges the gaps we experience during this time: telephones and video meeting apps, livestreamed Masses and mass prayer gatherings, films and music and digital books to capture the imagination.</p>
